The main referencing system used by Birmingham City University students is Harvard. There are many versions of Harvard, but the one listed here is the version that should be used at BCU. Law students should use the OSCOLA referencing system. Psychology students should use the APA 6th Edition as their referencing style.

### Where can I find Referencing Guidelines? - Library Help

The Harvard (author-date) system is comprised of two elements: an in-text citation and a bibliography at the end of the document. In the text of an assignment, ideas taken from other people are indicated by placing the author's surname and the date of publication in brackets. The bibliography at the end of the document then lists the references in alphabetical order by author's surname.

### Harvard (author date)

In-text citations: Harvard style requires the use of a partial reference to the sources you are referring to in the text of your document. The in-text citation appears in the format of author-date or name-date enclosed in brackets e.g. (Smith 2008); (Southern Cross University 2010). 2.
