Unfortunately, water quality can sometimes change. Despite the efforts of water suppliers, problems with drinking water can and do occur. When problems arise, consumers have a right to know what happened and what they need to do. The public notice requirements of the Safe Drinking Water Act require water suppliers to provide this notice. EPA sets strict requirements on the form, manner, content, and frequency of public notices. There are 10 required elements in a public notice.
