The morality system of Mass Effect 2 works on percentages rather than the total points earned. There is a set number of morality points available in the game. Shepard's current "effective" morality score at any given point is the number of points earned out of the number of points available from the areas the Commander has explored so far.

The morality system is a bit wacky in this game. According to the wiki, to pass checks / have paragon and renegade dialogue available, you need a certain percentage of the morality points you've had the opportunity to earn over the course of the game so far (rather than needing a percentage of the morality points you have earned or needing x number of morality points).

Such binary morality system were rather popular when the first Mass Effect was released with games like Fables. But there are many better ways of doing things in my opinon. Like in the Witcher Series where you are forced to make much more grey options or in the Dragon Age series where you have approval of you companions instead.

2.3. Occasionally renegade options (usually killing someone) grant you more Renegade points than Intimidations. But usually it's the other way around. 2.4.
