In 1944 Polanyi was elected to the Royal Society. The contributions which Polanyi made to the social sciences include an understanding of tacit knowledge, and the concept of a polycentric spontaneous order to intellectual inquiry were developed in the context of his opposition to central planning.

In "Social Capitalism," Polanyi is sharply critical of "a new conception of society based on scientific pretensions" (341). Eventually, Polanyi seems to include under the rubric "scientism" a range of things including narrowly reductionist, materialistic, mechanistic and objectivistic accounts of science.
