According to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office of Minority Health, 58 percent of the African-American population lived in the South as of 2017. 18 They are also more likely to be uninsured, with Texas, Florida, and Georgia being home to the largest shares of uninsured African Americans. 19 Some states have also proposed draconian work requirements 20 as a condition for the participation in the Medicaid program.
