The RACGP produces a wide range of clinical guidelines to assist GPs in their work. In addition to the RACGP guidelines below, the RACGP also recognises external produced guidelines through Endorsement and recognition as an Accepted Clinical Resource.

RACGP - Clinical guidelines

The RACGP has published the Guidelines for preventive activities in general practice 9th edition (Red Book) since 1989 to support evidence-based preventive activities in primary care. The Red Book is now widely accepted as the main guide to the provision of preventive care in Australian general practice.

The updated guidelines recommend as-needed low-dose budesonide-formoterol be used as an alternative to a daily maintenance low-dose inhaled corticosteroid preventer for the relief of symptoms in adults and adolescents aged over 12 with mild asthma.

RACGP - Significant update on asthma management

The guidelines feature several general practice scenarios and case studies, including how to respond to reports of a measles outbreak, antimicrobial stewardship surveillance methods, and information on glove use, hand hygiene and seasonal influenza vaccination in an office-based practice.

RACGP - Infection control update for healthcare

Urethral swabs for microscopy should be collected when the patient has not urinated for at least 1 hour and only if the patient has frank urethral discharge. Squeeze the urethra to express the discharge and collect on urethral swab. It is not necessary to insert the swab into the urethra.
