After the excavations, the materials which had been found, were brought to Istanbul in order to be kept. In 1901 and 1902, Macalister and in 1924 Reisner¹ published most of the handles which were approximately more than a thousand.

In 1930 she returned to Asia Minor to excavate Pergamon and Halai as well as tombs at Lapithos in Cyprus, and became a fellow of the Agora Excavations in 1932, an affiliation that was to last her lifetime. On the part of the fragment that would have been the inside of the amphora, there is a modern inscription in pencil that reads: "RHO, July 1968" along with a green numeral one or seven. The "RHO" could indicate it was found in Rhodes. Scholars continue to debate the significance of these stamped amphora handles.

These are indicative of the military nature of the site and the efforts to take it. The finds also included were coins from the reigns of Antiochus Epiphanes through Antiochus VII Sidetes, as well as a multitude of stamped Rhodian amphora handles.
